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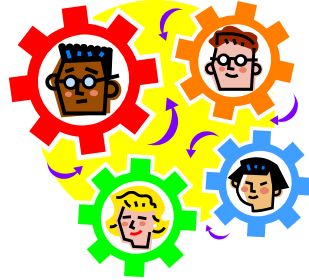
# Division of Labor



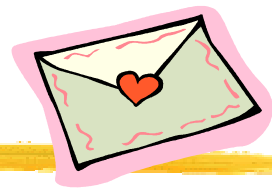
# Definition

## ❖ Division of labor

- ✓ Labors specify in doing one task or one portion of a task.



# Game Rules



- ❖ **Divide the class into 10 groups.**
- ❖ **5 groups will produce this card individually.**
- ❖ **The other 5 groups can divide their labor into several production lines.**
- ❖ **You will have 15 minutes to produce.**

•Since this is now close to Christmas/New year/Chinese New Year, let's make some cards for your friends and relatives.

•Teacher shows to students suggested graphic of the card design for them to produce later on. The card should have several pieces to trace from a pattern. (Refer to Figure 1 for the card design suggestion).

•Teacher distributes all the materials to students.

•You will have 15 minutes to produce and your time starts now.
